		1.	Original	<b>This checklist</b> , with boxes ticked, signed and documents in the sequence of this checklist.
		2.	Original	<b>Print-out of the Schengen visa application form</b> properly <b>completed online</b> , signed and dated on the last page of the form + a <b>recent</b> passport-sized <b>photo</b> according to the <a href="#">ICAO regulations</a> , pasted on the application form.
		3.	Original	<b>Print-out of the confirmation email</b> of your appointment.
		4.	Original + Copy	<b>Passport</b> with at least three empty pages. Issued less than 10 years ago and valid for at least 12 months when your visa application is submitted. Copy of bio-data pages (this includes the signature page).
		5.	Original + Copy	<b>Singapore resident permit</b> Employment Pass / Dependant's Pass / S Pass / Student Pass / Permanent Resident Identity Card + Re-entry Permit / Recent print out of SGWorkPass ...
		6.	Original + Copy	<b>Official copy of your birth certificate</b> (proof that you are over 21 years old) issued less than 6 months ago. If it is issued in Singapore: a non-laminated birth extract 'Certificate of Extract from Register of Births' issued by the <a href="#">Immigration Checkpoints &amp; Authority</a> in Singapore, authenticated by the <a href="#">Ministry of Foreign Affairs</a> in Singapore and legalized by the Embassy (fees apply). If it is issued abroad: see <a href="#">procedure of legalization of documents</a> .
		7.	Original + Copy	<b>Official copy of your marriage certificate</b> , issued less than 6 months ago. If it is issued in Singapore: a non-laminated duplicate certificate 'Certified Copy of an entry in a Marriage Register' issued by the <a href="#">Registry of Marriages</a> / <a href="#">Registry of Muslim Marriages</a> in Singapore, authenticated by the <a href="#">Ministry of Foreign Affairs</a> in Singapore and legalized by the Embassy (fees apply). If it is issued abroad: see <a href="#">procedure of legalization of documents</a> . <b>Official copy of the divorce certificate or judgement</b> (if applicable).
		8.	Original	<b>Medical certificate</b> issued less than 6 months ago, properly completed, stamped and signed by one of the <a href="#">medical doctors designated by the Embassy</a> .
		9.	Copy	<b>Identity card</b> of your spouse in Belgium (eID, not passport).
		10.	Original + Copy	<b>Medical Insurance certificate</b> issued by the Health Insurer in Belgium (mutuelle/ mutualiteit). Proof that your spouse has a health insurance policy covering medical costs in Belgium for him / her and the family.
		11.	Copy	<b>Proof of sufficient accommodation</b> of your spouse in Belgium. Registered lease agreement or notarized housing title allocated to principal residence of your partner in Belgium.
		12.	Copy	<b>Proof of your spouse's regular and sufficient means of subsistence</b> Attestation of family composition + salary slips of the last 12 months / last income tax statement for professionals / pensions / ...
		13.	Copy	<b>Proof of payment of the <a href="#">contribution fee</a></b> , to be paid prior to the visa application. The contribution fee cannot be paid at the Embassy.

I HAVE BEEN INFORMED THAT:

- my passport will be kept for the duration of the visa processing time.
- my application will only be eligible for processing when the submitted file is complete.
- additional documents may be requested.
